# Economic Development & Housing Work Groups: Appointments

- Each work group charter requires two City Council and two Planning Commission members be appointed;
- Planning Commission appointed its work group members on April 27;
- Work group meetings are in addition to other meeting commitments and scheduled to commence in late May and conclude in late 2022.



# Economic Development & Housing Work Groups: Appointments

- Based on feedback received from City Council since the meeting packet was published:
  - There is significant City Council interest in serving on these work groups; and
  - There is City Council interest in amending the work group charters to increase the number of City Council members appointed from two to three.
