

Lund Correction Letter V5

Tree protection fencing needs to be shown for all trees. Ensure all fencing is consistent with the distance shown in the LOD row from the table below.

Fencing indicated around all tree LODs where said LODs are on the lot or lot frontage (for trees where the trunk is not on the lot, tree protection fencing does not extend into neighboring properties for the reason that there will be no construction workers, and thus no disturbance, on neighboring lots).

The existing notes on the site plan regarding care around plants on neighboring lots, as well as existing fences and rockeries between lots, should suffice to prevent damage or construction workers entering into the LODs and neighboring lots at the lot perimeter. Construction workers will only be able to enter the lot from the street.
