Mr. Henderson,

I'm emailing you with human safety concerns in mind at 7430 E. Mercer Way.

The homeowners, Lynn & Jerome have done the following non-permitted improvements/repairs to their waterfront deck.

1. Installed an illegal covering over rotten wood decking. The covering is a rubberized material meant to emulate the look of the new see thru material that is required now by law. This was intentionally done because 100% of the wood underneath is rotten and needs replacement. It was an attempt to cover it up and make it usable.
2. Non-permitted repairs to the structure of the dock. This is evident by the use of cinderblock and chains holding the dock down to rotten piles. Every pile is rotten beyond repair, but in an effort to skirt Mercer Island and obtaining a permit, they continue to put people's life in danger on this unsound structure.
3. Moved their electric/hydraulic boatlift from approved location facing the lake to a new location on the side of their deck. This encroaches into the setback requirements. Just recently, the lift fell over in its new location and the owners by the cover of darkness dredged the bottom of the lake to complete a makeshift repair so it would be functional again.
4. Installed electrical and plumbing conduit in the back yard routing to an illegal sprinkler system that pumps water from the lake that waters their yard.

Such flagrant abuse to circumvent the system continues to put the residents/guests/and other peoples life in danger. I would appreciate if you would look into this ASAP.
