Whereabouts of dog (if not in custody of owner):

Pursuant to this notice, the dog listed above will be considered a "Potentially Dangerous Dog" under MICC 7.04.120 and RCW 16.08.070 twenty (20) days after service of this notice on August 23rd, 2024. This notice places immediate restrictions upon the dog listed above and requires your immediate action. Contact Regional Animal Services of King County at 206 296 7387 if you have any questions.

Declaration of Potentially Dangerous Dog

Regional Animal Services of King County has probable cause to believe that the dog listed above falls within the definition of potentially dangerous dog as set forth in MICC 7.04.120 and RCW 16.08.070 for the following reason(s):

- The dog listed above has without provocation inflicted a bite or bites on a human, domestic animal, or livestock on public or private property.
- The dog listed above without provocation chased or approached a person or person upon the streets, sidewalks, or any public ground or private property in a menacing fashion or apparent attitude of attack.
- The dog listed above has a known propensity, tendency, or disposition to attack unprovoked, to cause injury without provocation, or to cause injury or otherwise to threaten the safety of humans or domestic animals without provocation.

During the 20 days before this declaration is effective, on or before September 13th, 2024, you may appeal this notice. Information on how to appeal this notice follows.

The facts which support this declaration are as follows:


On 8/13/24, a dog later identified as "Ruby" ran off her property and attacked another dog in the road causing injuries requiring veterinary care.

Under Mercer Island Code, a potentially dangerous dog is defined as: "Potentially dangerous dog means any dog that when unprovoked: (a) inflicts bites on a human or a domestic animal either on public or private property"

The statutory and municipal code basis for the proposed action are as follows:

Potentially Dangerous Dog Owner Responsibilities

Pursuant to MICC 7.04.120(E), it is unlawful for an owner of a potentially dangerous dog to permit the dog to be allowed or permitted to run free and physically unrestrained or off leash or not otherwise under physical restraint, unless within a fenced yard or similar restraint reasonably designed to prevent the dog from running free and physically unrestrained. The top of such fence must be **at least** six feet in height as measured from the ground level, unless there is a secured top—full enclosure—to the fenced-in area. Further, such fence or enclosure area must comply with all applicable city codes. Please note that a dog solely under voice and/or signal control shall be considered to be “physically unrestrained.” Any person who violates MICC 7.04.120(E) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Pursuant to MICC 7.04.120(F), the owner of a potentially dangerous dog is responsible for taking measures to ensure that the dog does not escape the above restraints.

Appeal Procedures

MICC 7.04.235 governs appeals of potentially dangerous dog declarations or dangerous dog declarations.

A notice of appeal must be filed with the Mercer Island City Clerk within 20 days of receiving a potentially dangerous dog declaration or final dangerous dog determination (notices that are mailed will be presumed to have been delivered three days after placing the notice in the mail for delivery). No fee is required to file a notice of appeal. If the owner does not file a timely written request for hearing, the restrictions imposed in connection with the potentially dangerous dog declaration or final dangerous dog determination shall remain in effect for the life of the animal, unless sooner lifted by action of the animal control authority or a court of competent jurisdiction.

Form of Appeal. An appeal shall be written and shall conform substantially to the following requirements:

1. A caption reading: "Appeal of _____," giving the names of all appellants participating in the appeal;
2. A brief statement setting forth the legal interest of each of the appellants;
3. A brief statement of the specific action appealed, together with any material facts claimed to support the contentions of the appellant(s);
4. A brief statement of the relief sought, and the reasons why the potentially dangerous dog declaration or final dangerous dog determination should be reversed, modified, or otherwise set aside;
5. Signatures of all parties named as appellants, and their official mailing addresses; and
6. Certification (by signature of the appellant(s)) that to the best of the appellant(s)' knowledge, information, and belief, the appeal is well grounded in fact.

She stated she was walking with the complainant towards the end of Island Crest Way when suddenly the dog, later identified as Ruby, charged into the road and attacked "Poppy". The dog on top of Poppy and began biting at her head. They tried to push the dog off but they could not budge her so she grabbed the collar and pulled Ruby off Poppy. She shoo'd Ruby away who ran back to her home. Will deliver packet to MI Court. AAW




Me and my friend were walking my dog, Poppy, who was on her leash on the south end of MI around 10:50AM when another dog came running out of nowhere down a driveway and attacked Poppy without provocation biting her ear, head and neck area. My friend was able to pull the attacking dog off Poppy by its collar and then the dog ran back up the driveway.

I immediately took Poppy to the Bellevue Emergency Vet (see attached report) and they had to put her under anesthesia in order to perform surgery on her ear which was bleeding profusely.

This afternoon while driving back to my home I saw the dog and its owner, Patricia Wynn (7951 Island Crest Way), on a walk and informed Patricia that her dog had attacked Poppy earlier in the day and that we had contacted the MI police department in order to file this report.

Diagnosis:

1. Ear laceration secondary to bite wound

Discharge Instructions:

Your pet underwent general anesthesia during their visit today. Effect of anesthesia may include sedation, abnormal behavior, occasional coughing, nausea, decreased appetite. These effects may last 24-48 hours.

Your pet should wear an E-collar (cone) at all times. If they are able to lick/chew the wound/s there is a much higher risk of infection and breakdown of the skin/site.

Limit your pet's activity for the next 2 weeks while the wound/s heal. No running, jumping or playing until the sutures come out.

Monitor your pet's wound/s for worsening redness, pain, swelling or discharge. If you see these signs, or are otherwise concerned, please call or have them rechecked.

The sutures/staples need to be removed in 10-14 days. This can be done with your primary care veterinarian and you can reschedule your annual exam/vaccine appointment for that time.

Your pet has been prescribed an antibiotic. While it is ideal that this medication be given with food, you should not skip doses if your pet is not eating as this may lead to treatment failure.

Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs) must be administered as prescribed and carry risks of certain side effects. Do not give more than the prescribed amount. Do not give with any other anti-inflammatories like aspirin or ibuprofen. Side effects can include gastrointestinal upset, gastrointestinal ulcers or, rarely, kidney insufficiency. If you see any vomiting, decreased appetite or black, tarry stool stop the medication and call a veterinarian.

Feed half your pet's normal meal tonight. It is ok if they do not want to eat tonight but if they are still not interested in food tomorrow, please call.

Trazodone 50mg Tab	Give 1 and 1/2 tablet (75mg) by mouth every 8-12 hours as needed for anxiety or sedation.	30.00	Start tonight if needed.
Gabapentin 100mg Capsule	Give 1 to 2 capsules (100-200mg) by mouth every 8-12 hours as needed for anxiety or discomfort. May cause sedation.	40.00	Start tonight if needed.
Carprofen 25mg Caplet	Give 1 tablet by mouth every 12 hours. NSAID. DO NOT exceed this dose. Stop the med and call a vet if you see vomiting, decreased appetite, or black/tarry stool. Give with food.	14.00	Due tomorrow, 8/14, in the morning.
Amoxi/Tri/Clav 250mg Tab	Give 1 tablet by mouth every 12 hours until gone. Antibiotic. May cause stomach upset and soft stool.	10.00	Due tonight, 8/13, around 10pm.

Medication Refills:

Medication refills are not performed through the Emergency Department unless included in your prescribed medications. Please follow up with your primary care veterinarian or your specialty department.



Narrative of: PSO Scinkovec #929

On 08/13/2024 at approximately 1252 hours, I was dispatched to the report of a dog bite on the 7900 block of Island Crest Wy, Mercer Island, 98040. The incident occurred at approximately 1050 hours on 08/13/2024.

I spoke to reporting party Karen Kaufman via phone. She stated she was walking with her 5 year old black and white French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog named Poppy on leash and with her friend. They were walking southbound on the 7800/7900 block of Island Crest Wy when a dog came running down the driveway from a residence, later identified as 7951 Island Crest Wy, and jumped on the French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog, biting her multiple times on the head and neck area. The other dog was described as a light tan colored medium/large sized dog with erect ears, possibly a Cattle Dog type dog. Kaufman's friend immediately attempted to pull the light tan colored dog off the French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog and was able to separate the dogs and the light tan colored dog ran back to its residence. No owner was seen at the time.

Kaufman went home and immediately took the French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog to Bellevue Veterinary Emergency & Specialty in Bellevue, WA for care. It was confirmed there were injuries puncturing the skin to the ear, head, and neck of the French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog that were going to need sutures. She said the ear injury was bleeding a lot.

Kaufman stated in the past she has observed the dog in the area on leash with a female owner, later identified by Kaufman as Patricia Wynn. Wynn would step away from the roadway and distract the dog with treats when another dog passed by.

I emailed Kaufman a blank witness statement to complete. I also requested she send me the photos she took of the French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog's injuries and the veterinary records.

I spoke to Regional Animal Services of King County (RASKC) via phone. Sgt Smokoska advised RASKC would contact Wynn for a statement and advise the 10 day quarantine for the light tan colored dog.

On 08/14/2024, Kaufman returned her completed statement, three page veterinary medical report, and two photos (I-1) of the French Bulldog/Boston Terrier mix type dog via email (see attached). Her written statement supports her verbal one. The medical report confirmed sutures were needed for the injuries.

This investigation occurred in the city of Mercer Island, in the county of King, in the state of Washington.
