



## Sign Permit Narrative - Drizzle

Drizzle respectfully requests approval for the installation of new business signage at 7637 Southeast 27th Street, Mercer Island, WA 98040

The purpose of the proposed signage is to provide clear business identification, assist customers in locating our establishment, and enhance the visibility of our storefront while maintaining compliance with City of Mercer Island sign code requirements.

The proposed signage consists of one non-illuminated wall sign and one non-illuminated blade sign designed to be consistent with the character of the surrounding area. The signs have been carefully designed in terms of size, placement, and materials to complement the existing architecture of the building and avoid visual clutter.

Key details of the proposed signage include:

- **Dimensions & Materials:** aluminum composite backer with digital print logo directly onto the backer (store front sign measuring 240" x 17.25") it will comprise of three aluminum composite materials that will be bumped up against each other to create the width of the sign. The sign will be screwed using 8 self-tapping screws. The blade sign measures 18" x 18" and will also be made of the same material, aluminum composite material and will also be digitally printed. The sign will have #10 self-tapping screws on the top and bottom and will be mounted onto the pillar with steel mounting brackets.
- **Placement:** the store front sign will be mounted flush to the primary building façade located at the primary entry to the site. The blade sign will be mounted directly onto the pillar in front of the store.
- **Compliance:** All signage is designed to comply with Mercer Island Municipal Code, this signage is essential to our business operations as it provides wayfinding, supports public safety by reducing driver confusion, and communicates the presence of a lawful, licensed business. Since Drizzle is a tenant in the mall, we have no information regarding any proposed development.

We respectfully request approval of this application and are committed to working with the City to ensure full compliance with local requirements.
