We offer the following comments in response to the Mercer Island Watercourse Stabilization Project, SEP23-005:

- 1) Due to the complexity of this proposal, we recommend contacting the local habitat biologist, Jim Schloemer (James.Schloemer@dfw.wa.gov), to begin a pre-HPA process that will allow adequate time to ensure the needs of all parties are met.
- 2) The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife considers the stream on the property to be potentially fish-bearing based on our records. Further information for using physical criteria to determine fish use is available at WAC 222-16-031(3).
